- » Two semesters of related classroom instruction
- » End by August 31st after graduation

- » Have reliable transportation

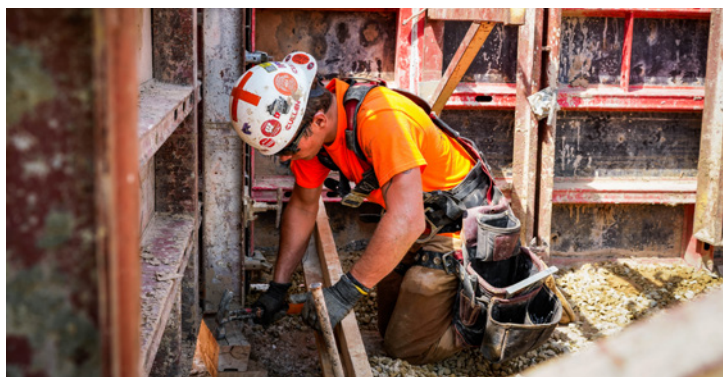
TIMELINE

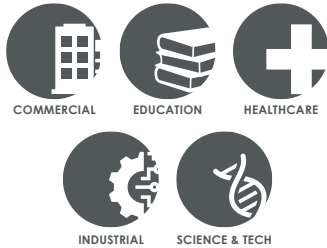

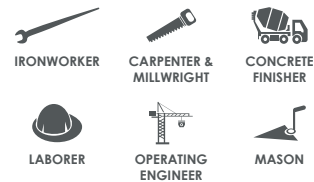
